Conducted in a retreat-like manner, this institute will offer participants an experiential understanding of the RCIA as they walk through its periods and rites. Together they will participate in catechesis, ritual celebration, and apostolic witness adapted from the vision of the RCIA.

Thursday, November 29 from 9:00am – 8:00pm

DAY ONE presentations include: An Introduction to the Ritual Text; An Evangelizing Parish; The Period of Period of Evangelization and Precatechumenate, The Rite of Acceptance, The Period of the Catechumenate; Apprenticeship and Mentoring

Friday, November 30 from 9:00am – 8:00pm

DAY TWO presentations include: The Rite of Election; Discernment and Conversion; The Period of the Purification and Enlightenment; Scrutinies and Presentations

Saturday, December 1 from 9:00am – 4:30pm

DAY THREE presentations include: The Sacraments of Initiation and the Paschal Triduum; The Paschal Mystery; Eucharistic Living and the Mission of the Church. The Period of Mystagogy

RCIA coordinators, teams, and clergy are invited to attend this institute and gain a deeper appreciation for the spiritual journey, catechesis, and ritual celebrations of the catechumenal process.
